# Safe boating - Navigation marks

#### **Channel markers**

Generally used for well defined channels, they indicate the port and starboard hand sides of the route to be followed when going upstream.

#### **Port Hand Markers**

Keep these marks on your port (left) side when going upstream. Light when fitted is RED.



## **Starboard Hand Markers**

Keep these marks on your starboard (right) side when going **upstream**. Light when fitted is GREEN.



### Isolated danger marks

Indicate the danger with navigable water all around them.

Two black spheres -BLACK/RED horizontal stripes.



LIGHT WHEN FITTED WHITE TWO FLASHES

## Safe water marks

Show navigable water all around. May indicate centre line or mid-channel.

Red sphere - RED/WHITE vertical stripes.

LIGHT WHEN FITTED WHITE ONE FLASH

#### **Cardinal marks**

Take their name from the compass quadrant in which they are placed and indicate the safe side of a danger on which to pass, eg north of a north mark etc.
