

Aboriginal Languages Trust - 2022 Aboriginal Languages Revival Program

The Aboriginal Languages Revival Program provides one-off funding to Aboriginal community organisations and groups to support them to commence their Language revival projects. The program aims to promote and raise awareness of Aboriginal languages in communities across NSW, consistent with the objectives of the *Aboriginal Languages Act 2017 (NSW)*.

Applicants can apply for grants from \$1,000 up to \$25,000.

The Aboriginal Languages Trust has allocated \$650,000 for the 2022-2023 Aboriginal Languages Revival Program.

Projects must be completed by 1 June 2024.

Applications close 5pm Tuesday 28 February 2023 (or before this date if the funds are expended).

Aboriginal Cultural and Intellectual Property (ACIP)

Aboriginal Affairs NSW has developed an Aboriginal Cultural and Intellectual Property (ACIP) Protocol that aims to build awareness and respect for Aboriginal Culture. The Protocol sets a standard for how the Aboriginal Languages Trust engages with Aboriginal People and Communities in regard to their cultural and intellectual property and what we expect from the organisations we fund.

The Aboriginal Languages Trust will not distribute or communicate any ACIP contained in SmartyGrants and agrees to respect the cultural protocols of Aboriginal People which it may apply to.
