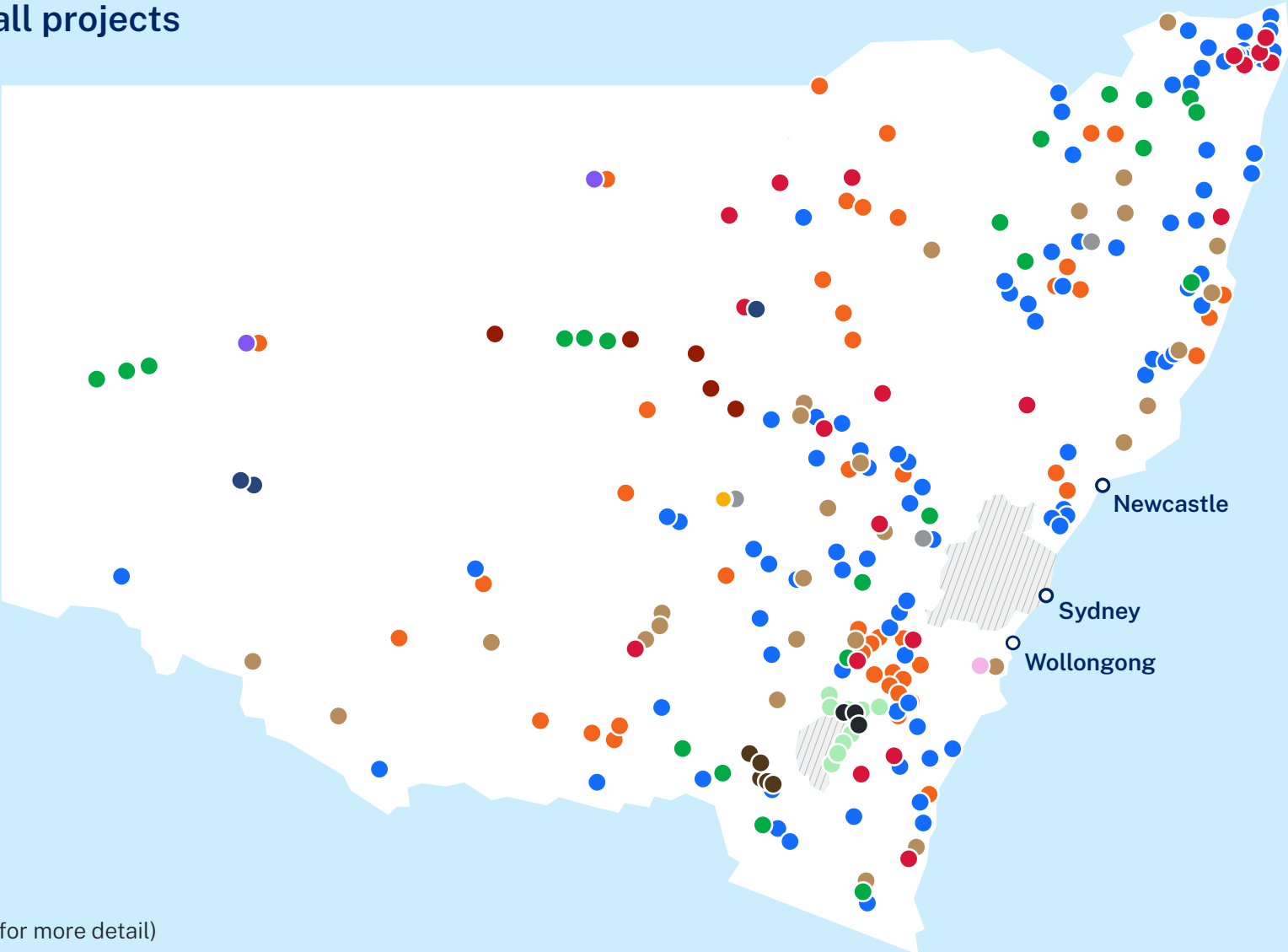

	<b>Smart Regional Spaces</b> <i>Partnership with The University of Sydney and University of NSW</i>	3 locations: Armidale, Lithgow and Parkes	A pilot program involving Armidale Regional Council, Lithgow City Council and Parkes Shire Council aimed to pivot the smart cities movement into rural and regional NSW. A suite of accessible digital tools, templates and training modules are available online to support councils and regional communities to reap the benefits associated with 'smart place' initiatives.
	<b>Snowy Mountains Highway Mobile Safety</b> <i>Mobile Coverage</i>	5 locations: Alpine Creek, Connors Hill, Caves Road exit, Lobbs Hole Ravine and Tantangara Road	5 small cell mobile towers delivering 4G voice and data services. The towers will improve mobile coverage along the Snowy Mountains Highway, between Talbingo and Adaminaby, to increase commuter safety.
